the wasing walks

We can create a unique route through the picturesque woodlands and lakes that surround Wasing Park for you to enjoy. Take this opportunity to have a simple stroll or have more fun by orienteering with your colleagues for a great team building activity.

'The Ale Trail, gives hiking around Wasing Park a twist, visit up to three country pubs set on the edge of the Estate, The Rowbarg Inn at Woolhampton, for a drop of the local West Berkshire Brewery Ale, The Butt Inn at Aldermaston Wharf and The Pineapple at Ashford Hill to sample their guest ale's (or simply have a soft drink or coffee!)

clay pigeon shooting

This fun activity is held on the edge of the Estate and includes full tuition. A variety of traps make it enjoyable for the beginner through to the more experienced shot. A competition is included with a trophy awarded at the end of the day.
